What is Sustainable Futures?



To make sure health and social care services are right for people, we have the Renfrewshire Integration Joint Board.



They decide how the money is spent to run services.



We are Renfrewshire Health and Social Care Partnership. We deliver these services.



Each year more people need help from our services.



Things cost more money now. We have to look at ways to save money. We call this Sustainable Futures.

Why make changes to the Health Visiting Service?



We have looked at different ways to save money.



Making changes to the Health Visiting Service will save money.

£168,451

Changes to the Health Visiting Service would save £168,451.



The law says that we must provide some services to people that need help with health and social care. This could be services like health visiting.



If we do not make savings, we may not have enough money to run the services that the law tells us to.

What is the Health Visiting Service?



The Health Visiting Service are a team of 80 staff.



They visit children and families a minimum of 11 times from before birth till the child is between four and five.



This is called the universal Health Visiting Pathway. It is available to all children and families.



They help with

- children's health and wellbeing
- child development,
- and support for families who need extra help.

What are the proposed changes to the Health Visiting Service?



They would remove just over 3 staff posts through retirement or not filling vacancies.

There are no other changes to the Health Visiting Service.

What could happen if the Health Visiting Service changes?



Less staff could mean

- Delays in visits
- Less time for extra support
- More work for staff
- Less time for important meetings

What will happen next?



There are events in June. You can have your say about the proposal to change health visiting services.



What people tell us will help the Integrated Joint Board to decide about changing health visiting services.



The IJB will make a decision at a meeting in September 2025.



If they decide to change health visiting services, this will happen from October 2025.

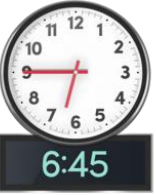
